
Blended Intensive Programme (BIP)

Basic information

- Opportunity to take part in a short-term teaching programme organised by a foreign university.
- Mandatory **combination of virtual and physical mobility**.
- Depends on availability.
- Duration of **at least 5 days** and **at most 30 days**.
- Suitable for **all levels of study** (bachelor's, master's, doctoral).
- The basic condition for the completion of the study stay is **the acquisition of at least 3 ECTS credits** (not applicable for Ph.D. students).

How to apply?

1. Follow the **website of your faculty and basic unit** to find out which specific opportunities are being offered and the conditions for the selection procedure.
2. You can also check the database of BIPs offered by foreign institutions here: <https://erasmusbip.org/list-of-bips/>
3. Choose a specific BIP and apply for it in accordance with the terms of your home faculty or basic unit and the organising foreign institution.
