# Financial Support at CU

Charles University offers the possibility of financial support, primarily intended for mobility purposes. The available funds and scholarships vary depending on the type of stay and the applicant's profile. Some of them are directly administered by the Charles University International Relations Office, while others are only mediated.

**Mobility Fund**  
The fund provides financial support for mobility stays ranging from three weeks to two semesters.

**POINT**  
Programme of Support for Internationalisation provides funding for short-term mobility (up to three weeks).




**FULBRIGHT**




## Barrande Fellowship Programme


